EDUCATION FINANCING

Strathmore students get loans from the Higher Education Loans Board (HELB). The University also has an arrangement to provide 4 year tuition loans with KIVA. The repayment period for KIVA loans is five years which commences one year after graduation. Bright and needy students can also get loans from the University.

OUR SPECIAL EXEMPT PROGRAMME

We exempt successful candidates from some of the units already done in their professional diploma in hospitality or tourism from an accredited institution. Our evening program runs from 5:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. Monday to Friday and Saturdays from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

OUR ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must meet the following requirement:
 - o KCSE aggregate C+
 - o IGCSE six B's including Mathematics and English and A level 2 principal passes and 1 subsidiary pass.
 - o O-Level six B's including Mathematics and English and IB 25 points with 4 points in mathematics and 5 points in English.
- A distinction in the Strathmore Entrance Exam
- Proven leadership skills in school & community and outstanding performance in extra-curricular activities are an added advantage

All candidates meeting the entry requirement are required to sit the University entrance examination in English and Mathematics and an oral interview.

Candidates applying for exemption shall be required to sit for a qualifying exam in hospitality and tourism.

Interviews are held on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 8:00 a.m.

Candidates are required to bring originals and copies of relevant academic certificates, 2 passport size photographs, a photocopy of birth certificate or National ID or passport and Ksh1,800 entrance exam fee.

Intake for the full time programme is in March and June.

Intake for the evening programme exempt is May and September.
